Edinger Medical Group participates in the California Immunization Registry (CAIR). CAIR is a secure and confidential computer program used by doctors, hospitals, schools and other health care providers to access an immunization history. CAIR allows participating physicians and agencies to view and update a child's immunization record. The immunization information entered into this registry is confidential and only available to your child's physician, schools, hospitals, and public health agencies.

CAIR has many benefits, including:

- Allowing our office access to your child's most recent immunization history, even if your child has received shots from other participating physicians or agencies. This makes it easier for us and others to determine which immunizations are up to date or overdue.
- Helping us keep your child up-to-date with the necessary shots by sending reminder notifications or other messages.
- Making it easier for us to provide up-to-date replacement "Yellow cards" or other paperwork when they are required for schools, travel, or your own personal medical needs.

We believe that this immunization registry will allow us to better care for your children. Edinger Medical Group's pediatric patients are included in this computerized registry unless the parents/guardians specifically decline participation. If you **DO NOT** want to include your child's immunization information in this electronic registry: Please request a "Decline to Participate Request Form" from our office.
